乳癌關注運動 力倡全民篩查

HKBCF Rolls out Breast Awareness Campaign to Advocate Population-wide Breast Screening

「你的健康,成就家人的快樂」

"Your Health Means Happiness for Your Family"

基金會於八月發起乳癌關注運動,以「妳的健康,成就家人的快樂」為主題,請來藝人襲慈恩及林愷鈴母女檔真情對話,拍成短片,以溫情帶出健康是維繫家庭快樂的要訣。藉著短片,我們希望婦女多留意自己乳房健康,支持本地實行全民乳癌篩查,守護婦女以至香港家庭。

近年本地乳癌防治政策未見進展,關注活動的目的正在推動市民支持香港實行全民篩查。除此以外,基金會希望藉此宣傳活動,呼籲本地婦女留意自己的乳房健康,並提醒40歲或以上婦女定期接受乳健檢查。

自1994年起,乳癌已位列香港婦女頭號癌症,而乳癌確診新症在過去20年增加了三陪。在2017年,香港共錄得4,373宗女性乳癌新症,即香港婦女罹患乳癌的一生累積風險是15位中便有一位。雖然外國有研究已證明全民乳癌篩查可分別減低乳癌死亡率及晚期乳癌個案達四成一及三成,但政府仍未制訂任何相關政策。

短片在社交媒體及各大商場播放。在8月2日至15日期間,該短片於各大 社交媒體上共計播放超過230萬次,接觸約104萬人,成效顯著。其中, 短片於重要持份者,即介乎45至54歲的社交媒體用戶間,尤為受歡迎。 這清楚顯示全民乳癌篩查得到廣泛支持。







The HKBCF launched in August an awareness campaign using the theme: 'Your Health Means Happiness for Your Family' and invited artist Mimi Kung and her daughter Ashley Lam to record a warming, heart-to-heart talk for a video to bring out the importance of health to the happiness of a family. Through the video, we hope that women would pay more attention to their breast health and support population-wide breast cancer screening not only for their own health, but also for that of the families in Hong Kong.

The campaign seeks to drum up public support for population-wide breast screening in Hong Kong in order to tackle the current stagnation in local breast cancer policy. Through this campaign, the HKBCF also urges women to pay attention to their breast health and remind women over the age of 40 to undertake regular breast examinations.

Breast cancer has become the number one cancer affecting women in Hong Kong since 1994, and the number of newly diagnosed cases has tripled over the past 20 years. In 2017, 4,373 new cases of female breast cancer were diagnosed and the cumulative lifetime risk of Hong Kong women developing breast cancer is 1 in 15 women. While it is scientifically proven overseas that population-wide screening can reduce breast cancer mortality by 41% and advanced cancer cases by 30%, the Hong Kong Government has no screening policy in place.

The video was shown on social media and at major shopping malls. Having been broadcast over 2.3 million times via social media between 2 and 15 August, the video captured a remarkable reach of approximately 1.04 million people. Among them, women between ages 45 and 54, who are major stakeholders are the most supportive. This clearly indicates widespread support for population-wide breast cancer screening in Hong Kong.

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「乳健同行 2019」山頂同行

Pink Walkers Gather at the Peak for "Pink Walk for Breast Health 2019"



香港乳癌基金會於10月27日成功在山頂舉行「乳健同行2019」。踏入第十五屆,乳健同行今年繼續匯集全城支持基金會工作,共計超過2,000名粉紅健兒參與,支持基金會推廣乳健檢查及教育、患者支援、研究及倡議工作。

今年大會以「妳的健康,成就家人的快樂」為主題,鼓勵婦女定期 接受乳健檢查,並積極推動政府落實全民乳癌篩查。

活動主禮嘉賓香港食物及衞生局局長陳肇始教授在開幕禮致辭時表示:「特區政府一向高度重視癌症防控的工作。食物及衞生局在今年7月公布了《香港癌症策略》,它是首個就香港癌症防控工作制訂的全面計劃,顯示政府防控癌症的決心。我們的目標是降低癌症發病率、向有需要人士提供有效和適時的癌症篩查及治療,及向癌症康復者和其照顧者提供可靠的存活支援服務。我們會繼續透過與香港乳癌基金會等社區夥伴的共同努力,推行多方面的健康推廣和教育工作,以減輕癌症對本港的負擔。」

The 'Pink Walk for Breast Health 2019' – also HKBCF's 15th Pink Walk – was held successfully on 27 October, with more than 2,000 pink walkers flocking the Peak to continue to show support for the work of the HKBCF in breast screening, breast health education, patient support as well as research and advocacy.

This year's walkathon rode on the theme – 'Your Health Means Happiness for Your Family' – to drum up local support for the implementation of population-wide breast cancer screening in Hong Kong as it would help safeguard the well-being of local women and their families.

Officiating the kick-off ceremony, Professor Sophia Chan, Secretary for Food and Health said, The HKSAR Government attaches great importance to the prevention and management of cancer. In July, the Food and Health Bureau published the 'Hong Kong Cancer Strategy', the first thorough plan made to address the management and prevention of cancer in Hong Kong. This administration is determined to lower cancer incidence rate, offer effective and timely screening and treatment of cancer to people in need, and provide cancer survivors and their caretakers reliable survivorship support services. Through working together with the HKBCF and our other community partners, we will continue our efforts in promoting health awareness and education in order to mitigate the burden of cancer on Hong Kong.'

基金會藉此年度步行籌款活動,希望增強大眾對乳癌的認知及對乳健檢查的關注。香港乳癌基金會主席霍何綺華女士致辭時道:「香港乳癌基金會是為支持乳癌患者及其家人而成立。為減低廣大婦女受乳癌威脅,我們一直倡議政府在香港推行全民乳癌篩查,因為早期乳癌存活率超過九成,而且要接受的手術較為簡單,醫療費用亦都較低。」

一眾粉紅健兒由山頂道花園出發,經夏力道及盧吉道,到達山頂凌 霄閣,為所有健兒帶來正能量,並希望藉此傳揚希望與力量予一眾 抗癌勇士,並肩同行。

The HKBCF wishes to enhance public understanding of breast cancer facts and promote awareness towards regular breast check-ups through this annual flagship fundraiser.Mrs. Eliza Fok, Chairman of the HKBCF, mentioned in her welcome speech that 'We founded the HKBCF so that breast cancer patients and their families can get the support they need. To free women from the threat of breast cancer, we have been advocating the implementation of population-wide breast cancer screening in Hong Kong. Breast cancer detected at an early stage has an over 90% survival rate and requires easier treatments and lower medical expenses.'

The walk was kicked off at Victoria Peak Garden before the pink walkers passed through Lugard Road and Harlech Road to finish at the Peak Tower. The experience was overall pleasant and positive as the Pink Walkers marched in support of the local breast cancer community. Those who are fighting against breast cancer could also feel the hope and power in the air seeing the huge and pink turnout at the Peak.



「一起粉紅」梁黃潔女士專訪

只要你曾参加「乳健同行」,不難發現有一班穿著粉紅迷彩襯衫的 参加者,她們人數最多,籌得善款也最多。她們就是「一起粉紅」 團隊。

「一起粉紅」是由乳癌支援中心將義工、乳癌患者、康復者及其家人、朋友,中心興趣班的導師組織起來,在梁黃潔女士帶領下,參加一年一度在山頂舉行的乳健同行,大家共同努力,籌款支持基金會的工作。同時藉此機會提醒乳癌康復者要多做運動,更想向外界證明乳癌康復者擁有自信,同樣可以活出豐盛人生。

梁女士分享她患病時的感受:「回想在2014年,一次例行乳房超聲波檢查,確診患上乳癌,頓時不知所措。我初診的醫生轉介我到張(淑儀)醫生去做詳細檢查及接受手術,之後在基金會主席霍何綺華女士的鼓勵和推薦下,轉介到乳癌支援中心。護士姑娘定期與我聯絡,給我正確指引,使我對治療增加信心,再加上丈夫、兩個兒子和朋友相伴同行和鼓勵,得以順利完成療程,為此我十分感恩。」

經此一役,梁女士看到支援中心同事對病人的貼心關懷,令她決心加入義工行列,鼓勵姊妹們積極面對乳癌。她寄語乳癌病患者多接觸支援中心,接受不同服務和參加活動,多結識同路人,互相扶持,攜手走過抗癌路。

梁女士呼籲姊妹們繼續支持「一起粉紅」,籌委會期望不久將來可 以安排姊妹們透過網上登記,參加步行及捐款 ,藉此簡化手續。

訪問期間,梁女士反覆強調「一起粉紅」的成功,絕非她個人的功勞,而是眾人各施所長,努力耕耘的成果。或許,這種歸屬感就是「一起粉紅」茁壯成長的誘因。

最後,梁女士寄語女士們要定期做乳房檢查,均衡飲食,每天做適量運動。萬一不幸患上乳癌,要積極尋求醫治,信任醫生,勇敢面對各種療程,不要放棄。緊記家人及朋友相伴和鼓勵,對病者有正面支持作用。



Let's Pink - Interview with Kit Leung

If you had participated in Pink Walk previously, you would have seen a group of ladies in pink camouflage tee-shirts, in the greatest number among the crowd and raised the most funds for the event. They are the 'Let's Pink' group under the survivorship program of HKBCF. The group is comprised of breast cancer patients and survivors, their families and friends, and instructors from interest classes of BCSC.

Led by Mrs. Kit Leung, the group has joined the Pink Walk for Breast Health every October since 2017, raising funds to support the works and services of HKBCF. Through this exercise, the ladies convince many that breast cancer survivors are self-confident and live an active life.

Mrs. Leung recalled, 'I was diagnosed with breast cancer in 2014 after an annual ultra-sound screening. Stunned by this diagnosis, I felt totally helpless. My family doctor referred me to Dr Polly Cheung for further tests and eventually surgery. Mrs. Eliza Fok, Chairman of HKBCF, later introduced me to BCSC where a nurse called me on regular basis giving me much positive energy to deal with all treatments. In addition, my husband, my two sons, family members and friends gave me a lot of encouragement and comfort along the way. To have met the right people at the right time and for the support I was given, I am truly grateful.'

Upon recovery, Mrs. Leung decided to join the volunteer group at BCSC. Her advice to the breast cancer patients is to take up the BCSC services and activities, meet other patients and survivors, and together they go hand-in-hand in fighting the disease.

Mrs. Leung calls for continual support of 'Let's Pink'. In the near future, an on-line registration and donation procedure will be introduced.

Mrs. Leung repeatedly emphasized that the success of 'Let's Pink' is not entirely her own effort but relied heavily on many people's involvement and dedication.

To conclude the interview, Mrs. Leung expressed the importance of having regular breast examination, a balanced diet, and daily exercise. If breast cancer is diagnosed, one must seek medical treatment, trust your doctors, fight the disease bravely and not give up.

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

持續倡議全民篩查

The Continuous Effort in Advocating Population-wide Breast Screening



基金會於去年9月向行政長官就她的2018施政報告提交建議書 ,倡議實行全民乳癌篩查。基金會亦同時馬不停蹄與社會各持 份者及有關政府官員會面,解釋有需要及早推行全民篩查,以 應對日漸嚴重的乳癌問題。

In September 2018, the HKBCF made a submission to the Chief Executive (CE) for her 2018 Policy Address advocating population-wide breast cancer screening in Hong Kong. At the same time, the HKBCF is sparing no efforts in meeting with stakeholders and relevant government officials to explain the need to put in place population-wide screening as soon as possible to tackle the increasing problem of breast cancer.



參與公眾咨詢

食物及衞生局(食衞局)、衞生署及醫院管理局在5月16日舉辦香港癌症策略簡介會,諮詢持份者對本港未來癌症政策方向的意見。

衞生署代表在會上清楚表示,要待該署委託香港大學進行有關乳癌 風險因素研究的結果公佈後,才會審視政策。基金會主席霍何綺華 女士在會上指出,海外研究已提供充份證據了,可作現成參考。政 府可循序漸進推行全民乳癌篩查,如先按其現行政策為高風險婦女 提供篩查。食衛局指在今年年尾會完成研究。

Taking Part in Public Consultation

On 16 May, the Food and Health Bureau (FHB), the Department of Health (DH), and the Hospital Authority organised a briefing session to seek the views of relevant stakeholders on the direction of Hong Kong's future cancer strategy.

DH's representatives made it clear that they would undertake a review of the current breast cancer policy only after the University of Hong Kong (HKU) had published the findings of the study on breast cancer risk factors commissioned by DH. Mrs. Eliza Fok, Chairman of the HKBCF who attended the session, stated that there was ample evidence from overseas studies readily available for reference, and that the Government could implement population-wide breast screening step-by-step, for instance, by providing screening to high-risk women first as per Government's current policy. According to FHB, the study would be completed by the end of this year.



遊說政府落實全民檢查

在5月20日出席支援癌症病患者事宜小組委員會的會議。會議主題 為癌症預防與篩查。該小組委員會是由立法會衛生事務委員會組 成。

張醫生在會上解釋基金會倡議的「全民篩查三步走」策略:即第一,先為高風險婦女提供篩查計劃;第二,為較低檢查率、乳癌晚期發現較高個案率及乳癌死亡率較高的地區提供先導篩查計劃;第三,以全民篩查為中長期乳癌防控策略。在席議員對乳癌篩查的反應十分正面,認為「三步走」策略務實可行。議員認為政府應有確切時間表去決定何時推行乳癌篩查。



考察台灣推行全民乳檢成果

台灣推行全民篩查逾十年,成績斐然,因此基金會主席霍何綺華女士、創會人張淑儀醫生、乳健中心顧問委員會主席熊維嘉醫生、立法會議員蔣麗芸、葛珮帆及癌症策略關注組代表在8月份曾到台北考察,除了訪問臺大公共衛生學院及台北康寧醫院的婦女健康中心,也參觀了台方為推高乳癌篩查率的流動乳房X光造影車,汲取當地推行全民乳癌篩查的寶貴經驗。考察團於9月在立法會綜合大樓舉行傳媒茶敘分享考察心得。

Lobbying the Government to Implement Population-wide Breast Screening

Dr. Polly Cheung, Founder of the HKBCF, attended the meeting of the Subcommittee held on 20 May to discuss cancer prevention and screening. The Subcommittee is formed under the Panel on Health Services of Legislative Council (LegCo).

At the meeting, Dr. Cheung explained the three-phase approach advocated by the HKBCF in implementing population-wide breast screening: firstly, to provide screening programme for women with high risk of breast cancer; secondly, to initiate pilot screening programmes in districts with lower cancer screening rate, higher breast cancer mortality rate and advanced stage breast cancer rate; and thirdly, to implement population-wide breast screening as a medium to long-term prevention and management measure. The three-phase approach was well received by attending members, who considered it to be pragmatic and feasible. They also considered that the Government should draw up a concrete timetable implement breast cancer screening.



Learning from Taiwan the Experience of Implementing Population-wide Breast Screening

As Taiwan has achieved remarkable results in implementing population-wide breast screening for more than 10 years, Mrs. Eliza Fok, Dr. Polly Cheung, Dr. Wai-ka Hung, Chairman of the Breast Health Centre Advisory Committee, Dr Hon Ann Chiang, Hon Elizabeth Quat and the Cancer Strategy Concern Group members went on a study tour to Taipei in August. They visited the National Taiwan University's Department of Health, and the Taipei Kang-Ning General Hospital's Women Health Centre. To learn from Taiwan's valuable experience in implementing population-wide screening, they were also shown a mammography screening van deployed by the health administration to boost local screening take up rate. In September, participants of the study group shared what they had gained from the visit at a media tea gathering held in the LegCo Complex.



發表11號報告書 發佈全港首項乳癌趨勢研究

香港乳癌資料庫在9月19日發表香港乳癌資料庫11號報告書,同時發佈全港首項以12年數據為基礎的乳癌趨勢研究。

這次研究結果指出乳癌測療技術不斷進步,也愈來愈多本地乳癌患者曾接受乳健檢查。然而,當中很多患者未養成定期乳健檢查的習慣,大大減低及早發現乳癌的可能。這次研究也發現12年來,香港最常見乳癌確診期數為 II 期,落後於有推行全民篩查國家(如英國、加拿大)的 I 期。

研究報告結果對基金會未來的全民篩查倡議工作大有裨益。

Publishing Report No. 11 and Hong Kong's first Chronological Study on Breast Cancer Trends

On 19 September, the Hong Kong Breast Cancer Registry (HKBCR) released its 11th annual research report along with Hong Kong's first chronological study on local breast cancer trends over a 12-year period.

The study found that a growing number of local breast cancer patients undertaking breast cancer screening amidst technological breakthroughs in breast cancer detection and treatment. However, less patients had their breasts screened regularly, which would undermine the chance of detecting their breast cancer early. As for the most common cancer stage at diagnosis in Hong Kong for the past 12 years, the study found it was stage II, which compared unfavourably to stage I in countries (e.g. the United Kingdom, Canada) with population-wide breast cancer screening.

The report findings will be very useful to the future efforts of the HKBCF in advocating population-wide breast screening.

遞交建議書 冀特首關注乳癌問題

基金會繼去年向行政長官提交建議書,今年10月初亦就她2019施政報告提交建議書,提供國際上有關乳癌的最新研究結果,並指出香港現時乳癌篩查的進度遠趕不上治療技術的發展。基金會認為須乳癌篩查與治療雙管齊下,方可守護婦女健康。

Making a Submission to CE to Raise Awareness of Breast Cancer

Similar to last year, the HKBCF made a submission to CE for her 2019 Policy Address in early October this year. The submission provided findings from the latest international breast cancer-related studies and pointed out that the progress made in breast cancer screening in Hong Kong lagged far behind the developments in breast cancer treatment. The HKBCF considers that a two-pronged approach of screening and treatment should be adopted in order to safeguard women's health.

The HKBCF Jockey Club Breast Health Centre (Kowloon) won the Hong Kong Institution of Engineers' Commendation Award in 2019 for its rainbow-like outward appearance that was designed to resemble the neighbouring Choi Hung Village. The use of multiple colours also delivers the message that like colourful butterflies, women can soar to new heights even if they had breast cancer.



基金會預見患者增加全港首辦淋巴水腫護理培訓課程

HKBCF Rolls Out Hong Kong's First Lymphoedema Training Course to Counteract Rising Breast Cancer Patient Number

基金會乳癌支援中心每年服務全港超過22%乳癌新症患者。據支援中心數據顯示,每三位乳癌病友中即有一位會患上淋巴水腫。淋巴水腫為乳癌治療後遺症,患者手臂會腫痛發脹,嚴重者患肢可比平時大兩三倍。由於無法根治,患者如不接受定期專業護理,生活將大受影響。

近年乳癌個案不斷上升,對淋巴水腫護理服務的需求隨之增加。然而,醫管局及坊間未有提供任何相關培訓,以致服務長期短缺。有見及此,基金會試辦一個兩階段的淋巴水腫護理培訓課程,由澳洲淋巴水腫培訓機構 Casley-Smith International 的一位資深導師教授。一共有九名資深護士完成課程,將所學的服務淋巴水腫患者。

只為服務病人

Angela是其中一位淋巴水腫護理培訓課程畢業生,本身在公營醫院服務。她參加是次課程是為了服務在公營醫院內,患上淋巴水腫,卻得不到適切治療及護理的病友。

Angela說:「每天都看到不少患者受淋巴水腫煎熬,但自己沒有受過相關培訓,過往香港也沒有任何類似護理課程,所以覺得無從提供服務,也只能將他們轉介到輪侯時間長,卻未必有專門應對淋巴水腫經驗的物理治療部。我看到他們受如此困擾,自己卻做不了什麼,也會感到不開心。」

「幸好自己得悉課程,所以決意在工餘時間修讀課程。很多人說 ,進修是為了晉升,但其實公營醫療系統並不視進修為晉升條件 。我自費來到這裡,唯一目的是在面對受淋巴水腫困擾的病人, 自己不會有無力感,而可以向她們提供適切及即時的服務。」

「以往要學習淋巴水腫護理要遠赴外國。我十分感謝基金會在香港開辦有專業認証的淋巴水腫護理課程,令本地醫療人員及病人都可受惠。」

The Breast Cancer Support Centre (BCSC) serves more than 22% of all breast cancer cases newly diagnosed in Hong Kong every year. According to BCSC's statistics, one in every three registered BCSC members suffers from lymphoedema, which is a sequela of breast cancer treatment. Lymphoedema causes swelling of the arms, which in some serious cases, it can cause the infected limb to be two or three times its normal size. Lymphoedmea, without regular and professional treatment, will gravely affect an infected patient's quality of life.

The number of breast cancer cases continues to increase in recent years, giving rise to growing demand for lymphoedema care services. However, the Hospital Authority and the private sector do not provide any such training, resulting in a service gap for a long time. In view of this, the HKBCF piloted a two-phase lymphoedema care training course, held in April and September. It was taught by a senior trainer at Australia's Casley-Smith International, an organisation specialised in lymphoedema. A total of nine senior nurses completed the course and are now applying what they have learned to serve affected patients.

My Sole Purpose is to Serve

Angela works in a public hospital and is one of the nine graduates of the lymphoedema care training course. She took the course as she wants to service patients who suffer from lymphoedema but are not able to receive appropriate care and treatment.

'Every day, I see infected patients suffer from the swelling caused by lymphoedema, but I wasn't able to help because I wasn't trained to provide service. There was no such care training in Hong Kong in the past. All that I could do was to refer them to the physiotherapy department where they have to wait for a long time and which may not have the expert experience in dealing with lymphoedema. I felt sad as I could not do anything.'Angela said.

'Fortunately, I learned about the course, so I decided to attend the course using my own time outside work. Many people say that further education is for advancement. In fact, the public health system does not regard further education as a criterion for promotion. I paid for the course myself for the sole purpose that when faced with patients suffering from lymphoedema, I do not feel helpless but can provide them with appropriate and timely.'

'In the past, we have to obtain lymphoedema care training overseas. I am grateful to the HKBCF for organising a lymphoedema care training course with professional certification in Hong Kong. It will go a long way in benefitting local medical practitioners and lymphoedema patients.'

淋巴水腫是乳癌患者最常見的終生後遺症,成因是淋巴系統受損,影響淋巴液循環,導致水腫。乳癌支援中心至今為超過4,500人提供淋巴水腫治療,最年輕及最年長患者分別為20及91歲。中心錄得最嚴重的淋巴水腫指數為270度。初至中度的淋巴水腫的治療期約為六至九個月,嚴重的需時一年或以上,因此淋巴水腫的預防及護理對乳癌患者是非常重要。

Lymphoedema is the most common life-time sequela of breast cancer patients and survivors caused by the damage of the lymphatic system which reduces its circulation ability. Breast Cancer Support Centre (BCSC) has provided lymphoedema treatment to over 4,500 patients and survivors, among whom the youngest is 20 years old and the oldest 90. The highest lymphoedema index that BCSC recorded is 270. Prevention of lymphoedema is important to avoid prolonged treatment, which usually lasts for six to nine months for mild to moderate cases and over one year for serious cases.

腫脹手臂 幸獲悉心護理

Carrie是乳癌康復者,早在2006年第一次發現左乳房有癌細胞,經歷手術、六次化療及三十次電療後,於2009年再度發現右邊乳房有腫瘤,因為前哨淋巴有異樣,所以手術中亦割了三顆前哨淋巴。七年後,她發現佩戴手鐲手腕後,印痕久久不散。

「我對比兩手,發現右手有水腫,於是立刻前來支援中心,檢查 後發現水腫度數是17。」

淋巴水腫指數,顯示手臂腫脹程度,負10度至10度為正常;10度至30度已代表有水腫;30度以上則算嚴重。

由於右手的水腫問題,令Carrie難以拿取重物。在支援中心,她先參加淋巴引流基礎班,再到進修班。於三個月時間內,她的淋巴水腫指數已回落至-1度,屬正常水平。

「我沒有掉以輕心,仍然每天做引流運動,保持至今兩年多,也 沒有反彈。」

如在淋巴水腫初期接受治療,便可改善問題。不過,病人必須聽從醫護人員指示,持之以恆鍛煉,才可避免水腫惡化。支援中心提供一系列淋巴水腫服務,以幫助患者控制病情。

A swollen arm well taken care of

Carrie is a breast cancer survivor. In 2006, she was diagnosed with breast cancer in her left breast and subsequently underwent surgery, six times of chemotherapy, and more than 30 times of radiotherapy. In 2009, a tumour was found in her right breast. She had surgery and three lymph nodes were also removed due to abnormalities. Seven years later, she found impressions around her wrist after having worn a bracelet.

"I compared my two arms and immediately found that my right arm was swollen. So I went straight to the BCSC for measurement. My lymphoedema index then was 17," Carrie said.

Lymphoedema Index (L-dex) indicates the swelling level of an arm. Between -10 and 10 is normal, between 10 and 30 implies an incidence of lymphoedema, while any number higher than 30 is classified as severe.

Due to the swelling, Carrie is not able to carry heavy objects with her right arm. At BCSC, she first attended a lymphoedema basic class and then proceeded to advanced class. In three-month time, she already had her L-dex lowered to -1, within the normal level.

"I do not let my guard down. I do lymphoedema drainage exercise every day. It's been two years now and my L-dex remains on a low level."

If treated early, the swelling caused by lymphoedema can be alleviated. However, patients must follow instructions given by medical professionals and perform the necessary exercise regularly to prevent their condition from worsening. BCSC provides a series of lymphoedema care and preventive services to help infected patient manage the problem.

At each exhibition, there will be on-site consultation service provided by registered nurses to enable the public to learn more about the importance of regular breast screening to timely treatment and increased survival rate.

共建自強座談會 Symposium for Patient Empowerment

根據香港癌症資料統計中心,香港婦女罹患乳癌的一生累積風險比率高逹每15位有1位。乳癌種類、治療方法及醫療護理等資訊對抗癌極為重要。基金會將於明年三月就以及相關課題舉辦座談會,藉此賦權患者及其家人在康復旅程中有更大的抗疫力及作出更適切的選擇。

According to the Hong Kong Cancer Registry, the accumulative lifetime risk of Hong Kong women developing breast cancer is as high as one in 15. Information on the types of breast cancer, treatment options and paramedical care etc. is of utmost importance for fighting breast cancer. The HKBCF will organise a symposium on the above and related subjects next March to empower patients and their family members to better fight the disease and make more appropriate choices throughout the recovery journey.

粉紅絲帶標誌的創立者 - 雅詩蘭黛

The Creator of Iconic Pink Ribbon – Estee Lauder

27年前,世界上沒有代表乳癌關注的粉紅絲帶標誌。於1992年,雅詩蘭黛的創辦人伊芙琳.H.蘭黛看到提高乳癌關注的迫切性,與SELF雜誌共同創立了著名的粉紅絲帶標誌,成為了國際上代表乳癌關注的標誌,並發起雅詩蘭黛集團的乳癌防治運動,其使命是創造一個沒有乳癌的世界,今年的口號為「團結你我,終結乳癌」。




